***Independent Review Committee Of New York’s Law Deans
Releases Summary of Activities Report***

Today, the New York State Independent Review Committee (“IRC”), comprised of the Deans of New York’s 15 American Bar Association (“ABA”) accredited law schools, published a summary of activities of its implementation of the review process governing the appointment of members of the Commission on Ethics and Lobbying in Government (“COELIG”). The summary covers activities undertaken between May 2022 and February 2023, resulting in the approval of 10 appointees to the 11-member COELIG.

“The State’s law deans have been entrusted with great responsibility through the Independent Review Committee in order to foster a greater public trust in the State’s government ethics and public integrity processes,” said Anthony W. Crowell, IRC Chair and Dean of New York Law School. “We are pleased that the new Commission on Ethics and Lobbying in Government has 10 highly qualified, independent, representative, and deeply committed members who represent the great diversity of New York. We will be watching its work with great interest and look forward to continuing our role in this process.”
