

## Resolution: Supermajority Vote Requirement for Critical Resolutions

WHEREAS, the New York State Community Commission on Reparations and Remedies is committed to ensuring that its most significant policy actions reflect broad consensus among its members; and

WHEREAS, under New York State General Construction Law §41, the Commission may adopt procedural rules establishing a higher voting threshold for certain categories of actions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commission hereby adopts a supermajority voting requirement for the following actions:

1. Approval of final recommendations to the Governor and Legislature;
2. Any other action deemed by the Commission to require heightened consensus.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such critical resolutions shall require an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (6 of 9 members) of the full Commission for adoption.
