JAMESTOWN WINS \$10M

Jamestown was selected as part of a competitive process by New York State to receive \$10 million in state funding to revitalize its downtown and generate new opportunities for long-term growth and prosperity. As part of this process, a Local Planning Committee (LPC) composed of government leaders, local businesses, and community representatives is working with a consultant team to develop a Strategic Investment Plan to prioritize economic development projects that will receive funds.

PUBLIC MEETING #1

On Monday, November 7th from 5:30-7:30PM at Willow Bay Crown Theater (21 E 3rd St #400), Jamestown will hold the first public workshop for the Downtown Revitalization Initiative (DRI). The meeting will review the DRI planning process and engage residents in a discussion about key goals for downtown revitalization and potential actions to create a more vibrant and prosperous downtown. The workshop will include a group presentation, discussion, and brainstorming sessions.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the DRI?

A \$10M award designated for investment in Jamestown's downtown by New York State.

What is the timeline?

The strategic investment plan will be completed by February 2017.

How is the money going to be spent?

Jamestown and the State will allocate funding to a selection of priority projects that align with the City's vision for downtown revitalization and make the most impact.
