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Common Core and Standardized Testing does not enhance the learning of an individual. Multiple choice tests does not give significant information as to what the student knows about a particular concept. It creates anxiety, sleepless nights, and does not prepare them for the real world.

Many Children of today are dealing with significant issues that society has placed upon them. Poverty, broken homes, taking care of younger siblings...to name just a few. It seems to me, there has to be a better way to prepare them, then the common core and standardized tests.

They are not a true measure of what they know, nor is it fair to jeopardize the teachers welfare based

on circumstances beyond (his, her) control...Teacher Evaluation
